Tuition and Make-Up Policies 2011-2012

Tuition is due the 1st of every month. If payment is not received by the 10th, a \$15 late fee will be assessed. If payment is not received by the 15th of the month, student will not be allowed to participate in class and will be asked to go to the front desk to contact you to be picked up. Tuition payments may be mailed to CDA, be sure to with enough time to insure receipt by the 1st of the month. All tuition payments are non-refundable. Family discounts are available.

Tuition is based on a 40 week calendar year and each month is the same tuition rate whether a student has class scheduled 3, 4 or 5 times in that month with the exception of August and June are paid at half the month's tuition rate.

If a student plans to drop a class, **written notice must be given to the front desk before the 30 days prior to the 1st of the month or you will be charged that month's tuition.** Tuition is based on the school year and is not pro-rated. Tuition will be pro-rated at the discretion of the director only for new students who register in the middle of the month.

An annual non-refundable registration fee of \$25 is due at the time of registration. Summer classes require an additional non-refundable \$25 registration fee.

If your check is returned to CDA due to insufficient funds, you will be required to cover the check with a money order, cashier's check, credit card or cash, plus a \$25.00 returned check fee, within 3 days of notification. If your Credit Card is declined you will not be permitted to use that card again.

CDA does not offer credit, extensions, transfers or refunds for classes missed. We do offer a make-up policy for classes missed due to illness, injury, school, or class cancellation and weather-related closures. A student may make up the missed class within two weeks in another comparable class or in a class lower than his/her level. Should CDA cancel a class, we will offer sufficient time for make-up or reschedule the class. You must call ahead to schedule a make-up class. We discourage drop-ins to avoid overcrowding.

Student Policies 2011-2012

ATTENTION PARENTS: The study of dance requires commitment and dedication. Please note the training requires a minimum of the FULL SCHOOL year to complete the skills and gain the strength required to move up to the next level. In order for students to progress, they **must** attend classes regularly and on a consistent basis. Our program insures the steady growth of each student, while not overloading them. Help your child(ren) to be successful by bringing them to all their classes on time, properly attired and well rested. If a student must miss class parents need to call and inform the front desk (303) 706-0273.

The academy year runs from August through late mid-June. We close for major holidays, winter break and spring break. Please see detailed calendar.

Annual Student Performance will be held in early June, dates TBA. Participation is optional, but strongly encouraged. There will be a production fee and extra rehearsals, no refunds for the participation fee.

Dress codes will be strictly enforced. (Specific shoes listed are required)

Ballet: Female Students: Pre-ballet-Level 1: Pink tights, solid colored leotard, pink ballet shoes, hair neatly pulled back. Skirts may be worn.

all other levels: Pink tights, solid leotard, pink ballet shoes, hair in a bun.

Male Students: Pre-ballet-Level 1: White T-shirt and black shorts, white crew socks, ballet shoes.

all other levels: White T-shirt, black tights and black ballet shoes.

Jazz: Tan Jazz shoes, tight fitting shirt and pants ("capris" preferred) or shorts that are appropriate length.

Lyrical: Tan Jazz shoes or "pedini" sandals, leotard/shirt and tight fitting pants.

Tap: Tap shoes, leotard/shirt and tight fitting pants ("capris" preferred) or shorts that are appropriate length.

Hip-Hop: Tennis or jazz shoes, loose fitting dance attire.

No bulky jewelry. Hair should be appropriately pulled back. Students must wear street clothes when entering or exiting the building.

All classes are subject to change. An appropriate substitute teacher will be present in the event that a scheduled teacher is unable to attend. Placement and advancement in levels is the decision of the artistic staff together with the academy director. Students arriving more than 10 minutes late for class may be asked to observe class.

All communication regarding schedule changes, upcoming events, news etc. will be both e-mailed to you and posted on the board however email is our first contact. Please update the front desk if you have a change in your e-mail account. Check the information board regularly.

We are not responsible for your child before or after class, on or off our premises. Please escort your child to and from class.

We are not responsible for any accident or injury that might occur on Classic Dance Academy premises or in any performance venue.
